Day Two

10.15 Depart Canillas riding in the Sierra Tejeda. Visiting Lake Vinuela and lunch at Colmenar. In the afternoon continuing on through Montes de Malaga and overnight stop at Alora.

Day Three

10.15 Leave Alora riding in Sierra De Alcaparain. Visiting El Burgo continuing through to Sierra De La Nieves. Lunch stop at Ronda. Afternoon ride to Gaucin in the Sierra Bermeja. Overnight in Gaucin.

Day Four

Leisure day to relax and enjoy the beautiful village of Gaucin which overlooks the famous Rock of Gibraltar.

Take the opportunity to visit the Mike Hailwood bar in Gaucin. Owned and run by the late motor bike legend's son David.

Day Five

10.15 Leave Gaucin and ride up to El Burgo for lunch. Afternoon visit Ardales continuing to Alora for overnight stay.

Day Six

10.15 Leave Alora riding the ruta de los Almoravides, visiting Lake Casaola. On to Lake Vinuela for lunch. Afternoon ride back to Canillas.

Day Seven

Depart Canillas for Malaga Airport.
